Nature Writing, for the purposes of this Prize, may be generously defined as literary prose whose major inspiration and subject matter is the natural world, not necessarily excluding its significance for humans and/or their interactions with it.

WHAT IS THE WILDCARE TASMANIA NATURE WRITING PRIZE ?

WHAT IS WILDCARE TASMANIA?

Members contribute around \$5,000,000 worth of volunteer work each year. WILDCARE sees this prize as another way of encouraging special connections between our hearts, our minds and our wild places.

CAN I ENTER MULTIPLE PIECES?

You may enter more than once, but they must be separate entries and attract a fee per entry.

WILL I RECEIVE CONFIRMATION OF PAYMENT?

Yes, once you have paid for your entry fee, you will receive confirmation of your entry. Keep a copy for your records. If you cannot find the confirmation email, be sure to check that it has not gone to your spam or junk folders.

WHO ARE THE JUDGES THIS YEAR?

The judges for the Wildcare Tasmania Nature Writing Prize are Tasmanian author and academic Pete Hay and Tasmanian poet and author Sarah Day.

HOW SHOULD I FORMAT MY STORY?

Online entries should be presented with 1.5 line spacing and in 12 pt font size. The pages of stories should be numbered. **The author's name must not appear on the manuscript or in the name of the digital file.**
